The Wessex Hashers look forward to welcoming you all to the Jurassic Coast for UK Nash Hash 2011. It will be fair and mild through the weekend, continuing for another eight hundred years, followed by cooling breezes and a protracted ice age... Dorset, Hampshire and Wiltshire are justly famous for magnificent Purbeck Hills, Jurassic Coast line, the New Forest and Stonehenge, and we can guarantee hashing of unsurpassed quality all within short bus rides from the venue. Nash Hashers will have full use of Bournemouth Sports Club site for the weekend and the main party area will be a marquee to be erected next to the Clubhouse. All food, Sat, Sun & Mon breakfast, evening meals Sat & Sun and Packed lunches on the runs Sat & Sun are covered by your Registration payment. There will be limited 'Crash Space' available on request— A first come basis.

Nearly 600 from 40 different hashes have several things in common, drink, runs, a little sweat and bull shit...

Clubhouse: There is a pay Bar and Restaurant inside the Clubhouse which will be open from Thursday to Sunday for those wishing to drink spirits and other special beers/lagers/Guinness etc. The 'UK Nash Hash Bar' will be open after the 'Opening' ceremony in the marquee on Fri, Sat and Sun, serving Real Ale, Lager, Cider, Wine (s) and soft drinks. A Coffee Bay kiosk next to the Campsite will be open from Fri to Sun early mornings & late evenings serving fresh coffee to all hashers at a special price. Hashers will have full use of Bournemouth Sports Club site for the weekend and the main Hash party area will be a large marquee erected next to the Clubhouse and we have a Fossils bar where the Hash Quack will visit...

Bistro - will be open 10pm to 1am on Fri/Sat/Sun offering Burgers, Chips etc.

Hash Charity: The money is going towards 'The Eve Appeal' Gynaecology Cancer Research and Dorset & Somerset Air Ambulance charity's. We have secured sponsorship for a **Red Dress** buffet and special **Red Dress** Tee shirt for all Red Dress runners on the Friday afternoon.

Hash House Heritage—In addition there will be the opportunity to join & support the Hash House Heritage Foundation project in Malaya. The two main objectives of the Foundation are to preserve the Hash Heritage and rebuild the Hash House. The original Hash House was demolished in the 1960's to make way for a freeway. Although the Foundation was established in 2000 it took until August 2005 before the Malaysian authorities accepted Hashing as a recreational sporting activity! (They must have missed the beer drinking part).

The Foundation was then granted a 99 year lease on a one-acre plot of land whereon to construct our Hash House as a centre for World Hashdom. The site is at a prime location set aside for sports related activities on the North West of Kuala Lumpur. This is the largest green area at the foot of Kiara Hill, rising 1,000 feet amidst lush tropical forests and the adjoining park extends to 200 hectares - enough for hashers to get lost in!

The design will include a public HHH museum as well as a members area with a bar, showers and meeting rooms. It will offer a permanent home for Hash Genealogy and a Hash Library.
